



Join Dallas College Academic year 2014

Founded in 2003, Dallas College is a tertiary educational institution that offers a three year post-secondary programme. The function of the College is to educate and produce a new generation of Muslim young men with the capacity for leadership at the national and international level.

Our courses are tailored to inculcate transformative Leadership skills, from digital media content production to geopolitics, literature and strategic politics, Roman histories, Urdu language, Islamic studies, fencing and cricket.

The graduates of Dallas College will be equipped with useful knowledge and insight of the turbulent world in which we live, and how to be leaders in the various arenas of power, influence and service from media communication to civic governance, and commodity trading.

If you want to apply at Dallas College, the process is much the same as that of other universities. However, at Dallas College the application process starts earlier to allow time for interviews.

Requirements of admission to Dallas College

1. Age: from 18 to 23 years of age. Any exception must be considered singularly according to the specific case.
2. Academic Qualifications: the applicant must have a High School (depending on the country) Matric, A Levels, Abitur or Baccalaureate diploma.
3. For the electronic registration to be processed, Dallas College requires the following:
 - a. Proof of payment of the non-refundable registration fee of R500 (Five Hundred Rand) to info@dallascollege.co.za.
 - b. A certified copy of the applicant's birth certificate, South African Identity Document or Passport.
 - c. A certified copy of the applicant's previous academic transcript.
 - d. A letter of intention: a handwritten statement written by the student. Must include a general biographical profile of the student, his reasons and expectations, and his intention to spend the full three years at Dallas College.
 - e. A letter of recommendation: new students must provide a Letter of Recommendation from their alma mater, headmaster, teacher or community member from the city of origin or residence of the student.
 - f. A good command of the English language: spoken and written.
 - g. Islam: the applicants must be Muslim.

4. Fees:

Day students: R21,000 (ZAR) per annum for non-resident students, payable in four installments of R7,000 (ZAR) per trimester.

Boarding students: R27,000 (ZAR) per annum for full boarding resident students, payable in four installments of R9,000 (ZAR) per trimester. The fee includes accommodation at the College and three meals a day.

Students with special merits and marks, recommended by their communities or by former educational institutions, will be eligible to scholarships covering part or, in exceptional cases, all of the fees. Students who would like to apply for a scholarship must enquire in writing to the admissions secretary info@dallascollege.co.za.

Payments are due on the following dates: 01/02/2014; 01/05/2014; 01/08/2014.

Accommodation

Dallas College offers campus accommodation in double and triple rooms. Each student has his own bed, table, chair and wardrobe. The College residence accommodates 25 students. Full Boarding students at Dallas College Residence are under the care of the House Master. Breakfast and supper are prepared and served by the students in regular shifts. Cleaning of the bedrooms and some minor tasks of gardening are conducted by the students under guidance of the House Master. Cleaning of kitchen, bathrooms and common areas is conducted by the College cleaning services.

2. You need to consider the cost of your tuition, your living costs, and where you would like to live while studying at Dallas College. You can either apply for Dallas College campus residents or arrange rented accommodation in the surrounding area.
3. Dallas College Application: fill in the Application Form attached to this pdf, with supporting documentation, and email it back to info@dallascollege.co.za before 15 September 2013.
4. Interview: those successful applicants will be invited to attend an interview.
5. Decision: We'll advise you of our decision before the end of October.

The academic year will start on Monday the 18th of February 2014. Successful applicants must be in Cape Town no later than the 15th of February 2014.
